Helena Agri-Enterprises, LLC Privacy Policy



Summary

Helena Agri-Enterprises, LLC ("Helena") and its Affiliates, defined below, collect information from you when you visit our website, purchase or use products or services, obtain financing, or otherwise interact with us. We may obtain information on or about you, your equipment, or your devices from third parties to add to our files or to complete transactions. We generally refer to all of this information as "Information We Collect on You." The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to explain to you what information we collect, how we collect this information, and how we use this Information We Collect on You. This Privacy Policy does not apply to third party websites that may be linked to our website.

Helena and each of its Affiliates, as applicable, may be referred to as "our," "us" or "we" in this Privacy Policy. As used in this Privacy Policy, "Affiliates" means any subsidiary or other entity that is directly or indirectly controlled by or under common control of Helena.

This Privacy Policy is subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Offerings – Enrollment Agreement and to any other agreement you have with Helena for specific products and services provided by Helena. In other words, in the event the terms of this Privacy Policy conflict with terms set forth in other agreements you have with Helena, the terms in the other agreements are controlling.

Please know we have a formal information security program to protect Information We Collect on You. (See the Security of the Information We Collect on You below.) Also, you can limit the Information We Collect on You. (See Opting In / Opting Out Section below.)

The following statements are made in accordance with the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C. 552a): The Risk Management Agency (RMA) is authorized by the Federal Crop Insurance Act (7 U.S.C. 1501- 1524) or other Acts, and the regulations promulgated thereunder, to solicit the information requested on documents established by RMA or by approved insurance providers (AIPs) that have been approved by the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation (FCIC) to deliver Federal crop insurance. The information is necessary for AIPs and RMA to operate the Federal crop insurance program, determine program eligibility, conduct statistical analysis, and ensure program integrity. Information provided herein may be furnished to other Federal, State, or local agencies, as required or permitted by law, law enforcement agencies, courts or adjudicative bodies, foreign agencies, magistrate, administrative tribunal, AIP's contractors and cooperators, Comprehensive Information Management System (CIMS), congressional offices, or entities under contract with RMA. For insurance agents, certain information may also be disclosed to the public to assist interested individuals in locating agents in a particular area. Disclosure of the

information requested is voluntary. However, failure to correctly report the requested information may result in the rejection of this document by the AIP or RMA in accordance with the Standard Reinsurance Agreement between the AIP and FCIC, Federal regulations, or RMA- approved procedures and the denial of program eligibility or benefits derived therefrom. Also, failure to provide true and correct information may result in civil suit or criminal prosecution and the assessment of penalties or pursuit of other remedies. NONDISCRIMINATION STATEMENT. The Information We Collect on You

The Information We Collect on You includes Personal Information and Raw Data. Personal Information is information that can be used on its own or with other publicly available information to identify, locate or contact you. For example, Personal Information includes information that allows us to identify and to communicate with you, such as your name, phone number, username, mailing address, and email address. Personal Information also includes relationship information which helps us understand your preferences so that we may offer you products and services that may interest you. Relationship information includes farm or business information, your general location, and other demographic information. Personal Information also includes financial information such as credit card information and information about equipment financing and leasing activities.

Raw Data is data generated or collected by your equipment and devices or by equipment and devices owned/operated by third parties. Raw Data includes land data, field boundaries, images, yield data, lab results, soil and tissue samples, agronomic data, information or data that you or your agents provide to us, and data generated by any devices used over, under or on the property upon which you operate; provided, however, Raw Data shall not include any information that is either publicly available or capable of being obtained from a third party source without such third party source violating its obligations of confidentiality.

We may also collect information on how you interact with us and our Service Providers (defined below) with respect to purchases, inquiries, and customer accounts. As part of this, we may collect financial information to complete your purchase. Additional terms apply to financial information collected in connection with financing obtained from us. For information on our handling of information collected in connection with financing, please contact your local Helena salesman, who will put you in touch with your Credit Manager.

Information We Collect on You does not include information or data which has been generated, processed, or modified by Helena whether or not related to any information we have collected on you. Examples of information which is not Information We Collect on You include, without

limitation, features, functionality, tools, analyses, results, estimates, recommendations and other information generated, published, displayed, transmitted or made available in or by Helena other than Personal Information and Raw Data.

How We Collect the Information on You

We collect information directly from you as well as from third parties. We will ask you for Personal Information and general business information when you interact with us, such as when you register on our website, sign up to receive a newsletter, or purchase one of our products or services. We also collect information on you when you use our mobile applications or contact us for customer service. We may also collect Raw Data from your equipment and devices when providing you with certain services. The equipment and devices may include farm machinery, implements, cameras, and drones.

If you interact with us online, we may place cookies on your computer and use other data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns. Cookies are small text files that websites send to your computer or other Internet-connected device to uniquely identify your browser or to store information or settings in your browser. Cookies allow us to recognize you when you return. Cookies also enable us to collect information about the device you use to access our website, your operating system type, browser type, domain, and other system settings, as well as the language your system uses and the country and time zone where your device is located. Our server logs also may record details of your visit to our website, including the IP address of the device you use to connect to the Internet, traffic data and other communication data and resources that you access and use on the website. The information we collect automatically may include Personal Information, and we may maintain it or associate it with Personal Information that we collect about you in other ways or receive from third parties.

How We Use the Information We Collect on You

We use the Information We Collect on You to fulfill orders for products or services, to improve products or services, and for other services related to your order, such as product delivery, maintenance, warranty service, financing, leasing, and credit services. We may use the Information We Collect on You to provide support, including monitoring and managing your machines, to deliver notices, upgrades and product improvement program communications, for diagnostics and repairs, to carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, and in any other way that we may describe when you provide the information. We may provide you with SMS, email and other communications and offers for products and services from our dealers, suppliers and partners, including offers based on your interests, personal and business characteristics, stated preferences and location. We may also use the Information We Collect on You for surveys, contests, loyalty programs and other promotional events, announcements, reminders, technical service bulletins, payment processing and financial account management, product development, product safety, contract management, website administration, web- forum management, order or contract fulfillment, analytics, fraud prevention, corporate governance, reporting and legal compliance. Helena may retain the Information We Collect on You for the duration of your business relationship with Helena, and for a period of time thereafter to analyze the information for Helena's own operations, and for historical and archiving purposes associated with Helena's business needs.

With Whom We Share the Information We Collect on You

We will not share the Information We Collect on You with others without your consent except as provided in this Privacy Policy. We may share the Information We Collect on You with our Affiliates, Service Providers, authorized Helena dealers and distributors, and other business partners, which may use it for the purposes listed in this Privacy Policy. We may share this information with Service Providers for their own use. "Service Providers" may include suppliers, dealers, companies and consultants that provide website hosting, software development, payment processing, order fulfillment, information technology and related infrastructure support, customer service, email delivery, credit card processing, legal and financial advice, and auditing. We may disclose the Information We Collect on You where needed to complete the sale or transfer of business assets, to enforce our rights, protect our property, or protect the rights, property or safety of others, or as needed to support external auditing, compliance and corporate governance functions. We will also disclose the Information We Collect on You when required to do so by law, such as in response to a subpoena, including to law enforcement agencies and courts in the United States and other countries. We may also disclose information and data about you that is not personally identifiable, such as pooled agronomic field data. We may also publish reports that contain aggregated and statistical data about our customers and equipment. These reports do not contain information that would enable the recipient to contact, locate or identify you.
